

Year 1 – Curriculum Information

Literacy

- Use a range of texts to include fiction and non-fiction books based around our topic theme of The Great Fire of London.
- Reinforce spelling and alphabetical order.
- Read and use simple dictionaries.
- Write/read/learn and recall the spellings of the week.
- Write in sentences with a capital letter at the beginning and a full stop at the end – to build stories.

Numeracy

- Order sets of numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Rapidly recall number bonds to 10. (mental maths).
- Sing x 2 /x5 /x10 songs and count along in multiples.
- To be able to solve problems using addition, subtraction, doubling and halving.
- To be able to do sums involving 1 more or 1 less, or 10 more and 10 less.
- Name common 2-D and 3-D shapes and describe their properties.
- Compare lengths and heights, using language such as shorter and longer.

I.C.T.

- Use keyboard to create our own sentences based on our topic.
- Add captions to photographs and drawings
- Use information from our topic to produce pictograms and simple graphs.

P.H.S.C.E.

- Learn about safety and people who help us
- Fire Service and Safety
- Continue our work on Zippy and his friends focussing on making and breaking relationships.
