LITERACY

Fantasy Stories

Read 'Stitch Head' by Guy Bass novel- carry out grammar and writing tasks related to this text

Look at relationships between character and setting

Grammar and sentence structure - nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs.

Use similes and alliteration to develop own descriptive writing

Analyse aspects of fantasy stories and write our own version

Group reading/ class reading and weekly year 4 spellings

Play scripts/ Drama

Pupils will explore how a play script is set out.

Learn what stage direction is and how this helps the actors

Read and act out various play scripts in class

Write own play scripts in class to be acted out by others

Learn and perform the play script for the Christmas Production

NUMERACY

Decimals including in money and measurement

Use written calculation methods to add, subtract and multiply

Learn multiplication facts of the 3,4,6,7,8, times tables

Carry out mathematical investigations and solve mathematical problems

Learn about different types of triangles, polygons and symmetry

Make nets of 3D shapes

ICT

Use ICT to research our Victorian Topic. Create a presentation based on the Victorians to include images, sound, movie clip and a hyperlink.

VICTORIANS

Learn about life in Victorian Britain enhanced by a visit to Beamish Museum where the children will study the daily lives of Victorian people. We will find out about school life in Victorian times by taking part in a lesson in the school room with a Victorian teacher. We will find out about children who had to work in Victorian times then compare the lives of rich and poor children. Inventions created during this period will also be studied.
