Year One - Curriculum Information

Literacy

- Texts for this half term will be the Tiger who came to Tea and Hairy Maclary and our literacy work will be centred around these texts.
- Some literacy work will be topic related and the children will be looking at differences between fiction and non-fiction.
- The children will be looking at dictionary work and alphabetical order.
- Continue with the Letters and Sounds programme.
- Continue with word level and sentence level grammar.
- Continue to read their home reading book and complete guided reading work in school.

Numeracy

- Count in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's and put these numbers into equal groups.
- Recall all their doubles up to 10.
- To know ½'s and ¼'s of shape and number.
- Use number facts to add or subtract pairs of numbers up to 20 and solve simple one step problems.
- Solve simple procedures involving capacity.
- To solve simple practical problems involving position

- Write captions using the keyboard
- Practical use of the interactive smart board in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Create pictograms and handling data (Numeracy).
- Use of related Numeracy and Literacy programmes in the computer suite.
