Literacy

Reinforce and apply word level skills through shared and group reading.

Use phonic build up of words.

Recognise capital and lower case letters.

Identify the main events of a story and act in drama.

Be able to put a story into the correct order.

Be make simple story plans using pictures.

Be write simple stories.

Be able to write simple captions and lists.

Familiarise the children with the school handwriting style.

Numeracy

Count at least 20 objects, moving up to 30.

Say if a number is 1 more or 1 less than any given number.

Recall all pairs of numbers with a total of 10.

Learn the names of common 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Use objects, pictures or a simple table to organise information.

Put objects in order depending on weight or length.

Use mathematical vocabulary and discuss how they solved a particular problem or puzzle.

Module 1 – Feelings

Topic

The Vikings

Geography – We will be looking at the different Scandinavian countries that the Vikings came from, where they are in relation to Britain and the design of their flags. Homework will be set to identify any special features of the country and the class will report back to each other.

History – The children will be looking at who the Vikings were, why they came to Britain, and where they settled, they will also be looking at their religion.
