Entering and Exiting School

There will be staff on hand to direct children to the right place tomorrow morning.

We have a new climbing wall for the children to enjoy and lunch and breaktimes. Please do not allow your children to climb on this before or after school.

Please ensure children dismount scooters prior to entering school and park them up. Also a reminder not to bring dogs on to the premises. Thank you for your co-operation.

Coffee Mornings

We will be hosting welcome Coffee Mornings for each year group next week. You will be able to meet your child's new class teacher and hear about how to support your child throughout the year.

Community Coffee Mornings

Our community coffee mornings will also continue and all are welcome. This term these will take place after drop off in the large hall on Friday 3rd October and Friday 7th November.

School Lunches

A reminder that all children from Reception to Year 2 are entitled to a free school meals. Theresa (our school cook) and the team work really hard to provide meals that the children (and staff) will enjoy. We will be holding a taster day in October for any children who are normally on packed lunches and would like to try a school meal. More information to follow.

Nut Allergies / Packed Lunches

We have children in school with severe nut allergies.

There is a ban on all nut products in school. This means staff, visitors and children are not allowed to bring in anything containing nuts for lunches or snacks.

This obviously includes **Nutella** and hazelnut spreads, chocolate and cereal bars with nuts, peanut butter sandwiches or any whole nuts. Any nut products brought into school will be confiscated and disposed of.

Please be very mindful as to what goes into your child's packed lunchbox.

Curriculum Plans

We will not send out paper copies however curriculum plans will be sent via parent mail and saved on the school website.

The half termly curriculum plans give you an overview of the knowledge and skills your child will be working towards. We hope this will enable you to support them and discuss their learning with them at home.

Out of School Club

The out of school club runs our wrap around care before and after school. If you wish to use this provision please contact the school office.

School Attendance

Regular and punctual attendance is vital for your child's wellbeing and progress. Children are expected to be in school for 190 school days per year. If your child is absent for more than seven days over a school year their attendance will fall below the expected, acceptable attendance. Children should only be absent from school if they are feeling too unwell to attend. As far as possible, medical and dental appointments should be made for during school holidays or outside the school day. Please do not book holidays in term time – they will not be authorised.

Friday Enrichment Activities

Children have a choice of enrichment activities on Friday afternoon from 1.30-2.30pm – an email regarding choices will be sent out on Tuesday 3rd September.

Please ensure the children have suitable outdoor clothing for the clubs they are taking part in as we aim for outdoor clubs to be out wherever possible.

If you'd like to bring wellies or old trainers for forest school and leave them at school that would be fine.

Private Social Media Accounts

Each year group has a private messenger or whatsapp group where parents share information and organise social events. School does not take any responsibility for these accounts but if you are new to school or wish to join please speak to another parent/carer who should be able to add you to the group. Please ensure that any social media presence does not bring the school into disrepute and any concerns are brought straight to the attention of the Head Teacher.



We regularly talk to the children about how to keep themselves safe. We will ask the children to ‘**Show Me 5**’ - they hold up their hands and talk about 5 ways that they can stay safe. We do this for different situations. For example:

At school (e.g. stay safe online, walk slowly in the corridor, carry scissors correctly, wash our hands)

Outside (e.g. Walk on pavement, cross roads at a crossing / with an adult, wear bright clothing if it is dark, do not speak to strangers, water / beach safety)

Asking your child to do this at home is really helpful in supporting these messages and keeping them safe.

If you would like any further information on how to keep your child safe or you ever have concerns about a child please get in touch with school. One of our Designated Safeguarding Leads (Mrs Ash, Mr Donnelly, Mrs Parker and Mr Wright) would be happy to advise you.
