



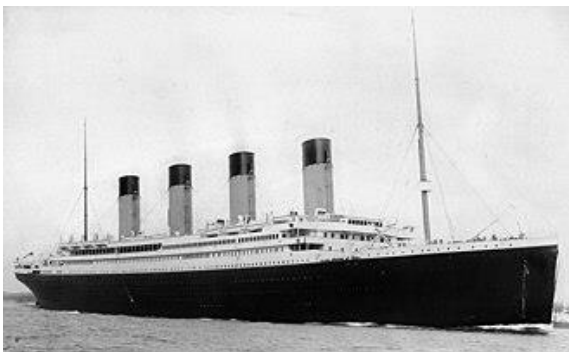

Chronological	Putting events in the order they happened, from the oldest to the newest.
Water transportation	Ways of travelling or moving goods across water, such as boats and ships.
Limitations	Things that stop something from working as well as it could, or problems that make it less useful.
Canoe	A small, light boat that is usually moved by paddles.
Long boat	A long, narrow Viking boat used for travelling, trading, and exploring.
Radar	A technology that uses radio waves to help ships find out what is around them.
Industrial Revolution	A time when new machines and steam engines changed how people worked and travelled.
