Hue	Describing an exact colour: sky blue, dark green, rose pink
Mix	Combining two or more colours together
Pattern	Pattern is a design in which shapes, colours or lines are repeated
Primary colours	Red, yellow and blue
Print	Transferring an image onto another surface, e.g. finger printing
Secondary colours	Orange, green and purple and made by mixing two primary colours together



About the Artist

Born in 1872.

Became an art teacher in 1892.

First started painting landscape pictures of the countryside.

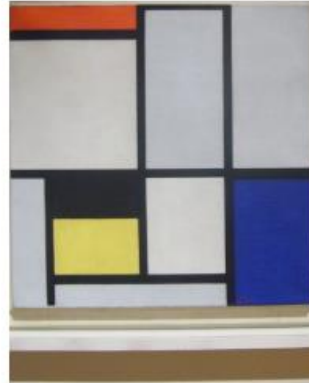
Developed the art style called 'cubism'.

Painted using lines and rectangles.

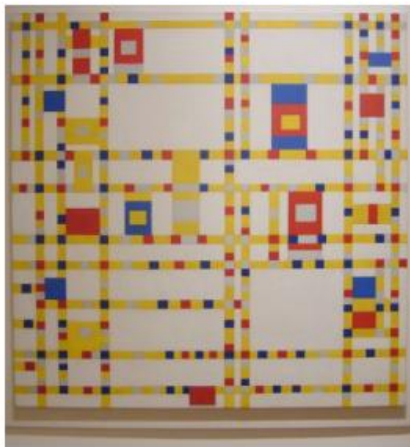
Used the primary colours; red, blue and yellow, plus black and white.

Died of pneumonia in 1944 aged 62.

His art style is still popular today.
