

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Major Body Part</b>	A big part of the body that do big movements. Arms, legs, hands, feet, and head.
<b>Minor Body Part</b>	A small body part mostly responsible for the senses. Eyes, ears, mouth, nose, and fingers.
<b>Senses</b>	How you take in information about the world around you.
<b>Sight</b>	Your eyes letting your see the things around you.
<b>Taste</b>	Your sense of taste comes from your tongue. It can taste bitter and sweet things.
<b>Smell</b>	You can smell with your nose. Your nose will tell you if something smells nice or not.
<b>Touch</b>	Your skin gives you the sense of touch. You can tell if something if hot, cold, rough, or smooth without even looking at it.
<b>Hearing</b>	Your ears listen to the different things around you. Your brain can tell what different sounds are.

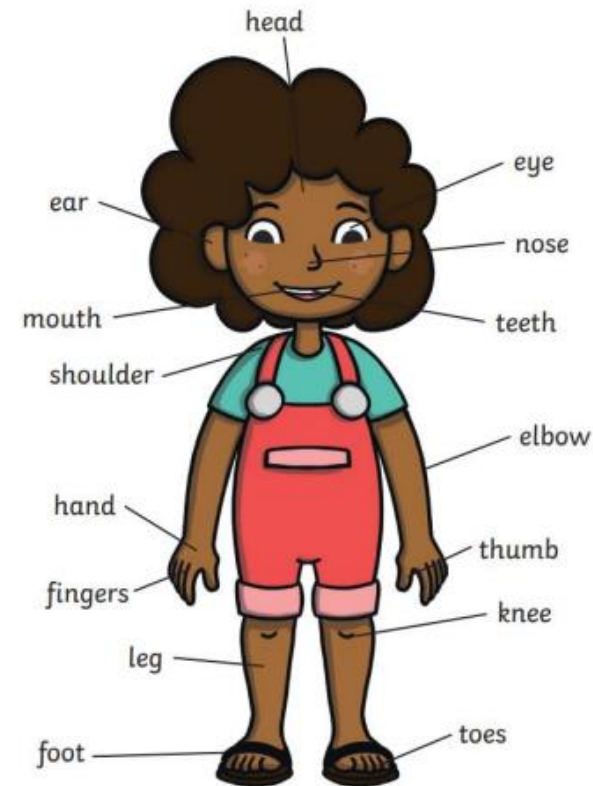
