## Key Vocabulary

Crucified – to be put to death on the cross.

Easter – a celebration of Jesus's resurrection.

Hosanna – a saying of joy or praise.

Lent – the 40 days and nights leading up to Easter Sunday.

Resurrection – to come back from the dead Sacrifice – to give something up.

Tomb – a cave used for burial
