Key Vocabulary

Pattern	Repeated decorative design
Colour palette	Selection of colour for an artwork
Repeat	Do something again
Symmetrical	Produce a mirror opposite
Texture	The feel of a surface
Craftsperson	Someone who makes and designs crafts
Mood board	A collection of images and/or designs which evoke a certain style
Develop Theme	Advance an idea or project
Batik	Method of creating designs using cloth and paints

Learning Intention: To explore pattern and repetition to create artworks with multiple media.

- To understand how design is employed to develop themes and concept.
- To appreciate how art is made for different purposes and learn techniques appropriate for the desired function.

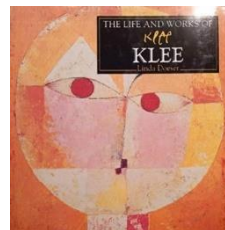
Key Knowledge
