Key Vocabulary

Allies	Countries who fought on the British side.
Axis	Countries who fought on the German side.
Evacuee	Someone who is moved to a safer location.
Rationing	The controlled distribution of limited resources.
Nazi	Member of a fascist political party which came to power in Germany in 1933.
Fascism	Right wing political view with extreme nationalistic beliefs and strict obedience to the state/leader.
Holocaust	The mass murder of Jews and other groups by the Nazis.
Blitz	Bombing attacks on the UK.

Key Knowledge

- Understand Britain's position before WW2. – Learn about the reasons for WW2. – Learn about the pivotal battles and the fatalities. – Learn how the British population managed during the conflict. – Explore WW2 beyond Europe and the political landscape (and corrupt beliefs) which contributed to war. – Learn about the consequences of WW2.
