Key vocabulary

Line	A mark made by moving a pencil, pen etc across a surface. They can be straight, wavy, zigzag, thick or thin.
Pattern	Something that repeats over and over again.
Texture	The way something feels when you touch it, or how it looks like it would feel. For example, in art we can make things look bumpy, fuzzy, smooth or rough.
Illustration	A picture that helps to explain an idea.
Calm colours	Quiet, peaceful colours that help you feel relaxed (blue, green)
Outline	The line that goes around the very edge of an object or shape.
