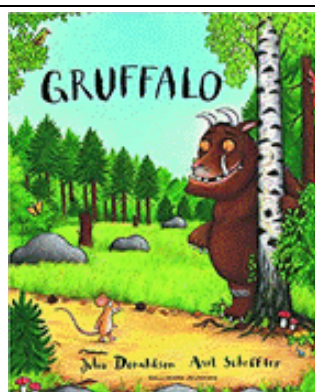


SPRING 1 CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR YEAR 1



ENGLISH

Talk for Writing Text – The Gruffalo

- Orally rehearse story of The Gruffalo using text map and actions.
- Take part in drama related activities based on The Gruffalo including use of props, masks, puppets, etc. Hot seat

characters.

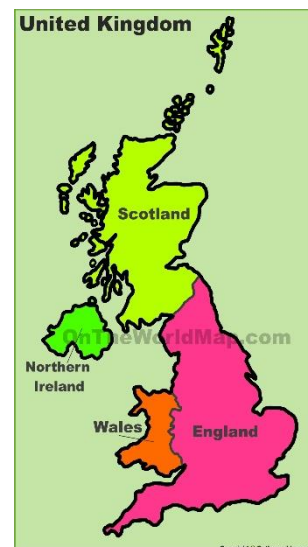
- Focus upon elements of writing stories, in particular characterisation.
- Discuss descriptions of The Gruffalo and the use of adjectives. Create 'Wanted' posters for The Gruffalo.
- Focus upon the use of full stops and capital letters.
- Change parts of original text map to innovate and write own Gruffalo story.
- Continue phonics and reading through Read, Write, Inc.
- Weekly spellings of spelling rules and common exception words

MATHS – Multiplication and Division

- Recall number bonds to 10 and begin to learn number bonds to 20.
 - Count in 10s.
 - Place value within 20.
 - Add and subtract within 20.
 - Place value within 50.
- Solve problem solving and reasoning questions

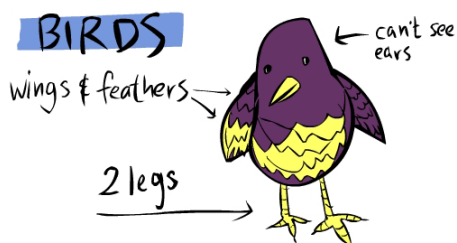
GEOGRAPHY

- Identify the 4 countries in the UK on a map.
- Identify characteristics of the countries within the UK including landmarks, food, traditions.



SCIENCE

- Recap on different animal groups.
- Describe the body parts of different animals.
- Identify and group different animal parts.
- Compare the body parts of different animals.
- Know the purpose of different parts of an animal.



Computing

- Understand what the internet is and how we can assess it.
- Know what we can do online and know what is safe to use.
- Identify people and resources to help you stay safe online.

RE

- Know the key facts about Chinese New Year.
- Understand Chinese Zodiac.



PHSCE – Feelings

- Identify feeling and emotions.
- Understand what it feels like to have a strong emotion.
- Identify the feelings of worry and anxiety.
- Recognise a good or bad relationship.
- Understand where to go and what to do to help me with my feelings.
