

ENGLISH

Read *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark*. Using Talk for Writing, the children will orally rehearse and learn a non-chronological report on Owls. They will then innovate this to write a report about a Tawney Owl and then move on to research and write independently another report on a nocturnal animal.

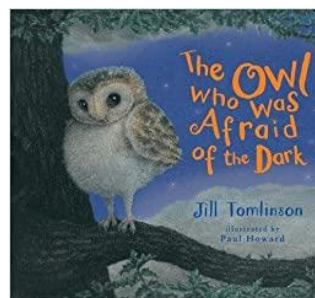
Spellings Y1 National Curriculum spelling lists are sent home for the half term. These are practised in class. Please also study these at home by writing the words and focusing on the spelling pattern. Non-negotiable spellings are also learnt in school.

Phonics

Revise and write phonic sounds to develop fluency and speed in reading through Read Write Inc groups as well as phonics work in class.

Handwriting

Practice forming lower-case letters correctly with attention to equal size of letters within a word.



R.E.

Learn that there are different religions and at this time of year there are lots of different celebrations - Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas. Identify and discuss the different features of each celebration. Look at the story of the nativity and the significance it has.



MATHS – Addition/Subtraction, Shape, Place Value to 20.

- Use part whole model.
- Record addition facts.
- Find number bonds to 10.
- Finding a part.
- Subtraction – taking away, how many left? Finding a part, breaking apart.
- Recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes.
- Count forwards and backwards and write numbers to 20.
- Count one more and one less.
- Compare numbers and order numbers.

HISTORY

Recognise difference between past, present and future. Compare schools from past and present. Order homes chronologically.



SCIENCE

Children will be learning about Materials. They will learn the name of different materials and sort them into groups. Children will learn that objects are made from different materials. Children will develop the correct scientific language to describe different materials. They will understand what each property means. Children will investigate materials to find out which ones are waterproof.

ART & DT

Children will learn basic techniques using hand printing and will then explore printing with other materials. Design Technology will incorporate designing and making a Christmas decoration.
