**New School Update** 

We are now settled into our new school. The children are enjoying having lots of space both indoors and out and they are very excited when it is their turn to go into the practical room and library. Phase Two of the building works is well under way and the old building could be demolished as early as March. Work will then begin on the landscaping, staff car park and early years play area.

## **Reporting Absences**

If your child is ill or unable to attend school for any reason please inform the school on the first day of absence. This should be followed by a note handed to the class teacher explaining why he/she has been absent when they return to school. The school **must** be informed of the reason for all absences; otherwise they will be recorded as unauthorised.

## Walking to School

We continue to take part in the WOW Challenge. Staff complete the Travel Tracker each day and those children walking/parking and striding at least once each week are rewarded with a themed badge at the end of the month. Since joining the challenge we have seen an increase in the number of children parking and striding.

As you can see the number of children arriving late in the first half of the term has been in double figures each week. Some of this is due to the move to the new building and the introduction of the bell to indicate when class room doors are closed but we are well settled into our new building now and it is really important that children arrive on time and make a good start to the day.

Attendance figures are good for this half term and for the most part have been over 95% each week.

Year 1 have the best average attendance for the half term, followed closely by Reception class and Year 3. Both Year 1 and Year 3 have had 100% attendance at least once this half term.

## **School Website**

Our school website has been redesigned and we are currently updating the information on it. All newsletters are placed on the site and a calendar of events is also regularly updated. Policies with regard to attendance, behaviour and school uniform are also on the site. Don't forget that we now produce a weekly class blog which gives details about the various activities that children take part in throughout the week.

This half term our children have taken part in a number of Trust events. As part of Gosforth Gets Going some children from Year 1 attended a Zumba session. Children from our School Council are working with other Trust schools to produce a Trust video and a groups of children from Year 4 have attended a Ceilidh and Arts and Culture workshop.
