

Year 3 – Curriculum Information

Literacy

Non-chronological reports

- Study a range of non-chronological reports focusing upon features of this genre of writing. Explore and discuss layout and structure.
- Research information about The Victorians and then use information to write a report.

Information texts

- Explore and analyse information texts relating to topic of The Victorians.
- Look at the features of information texts such as headings, subheadings, captions, font types, contents pages etc.

Numeracy

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
- Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of addition and subtraction.
- Solve problems involving addition and subtraction.

Topic – The Victorians

- Research information relating to Queen Victoria.
- Explore and place important Victorian events on timeline.
- Explore aspects of Victorian Schooling, compare to school today and write a diary entry.
- Explore differences between poor and rich children in Victorian times.
- Explore different Victorian toys and design poster to advertise a chosen toy.
- Learn about Victorian inventions.
- Learn about famous Victorian people.

I.C.T

- Use key search to research information relating to The Victorians.
- Use features such as copy and paste to select and retrieve relevant information.
- Use information to create a fact file about Queen Victoria. Focus upon editing skills such as font size, colour, etc.

R.E. – Meanings within Christmas

- Explore ways in which Christians find meaning in the accounts and stories of Jesus' birth.
- Learn about the key features of the nativity story and discuss different feelings, hopes and motives.
- Learn about the importance of Bethlehem for many Christians.

P.S.H.C.E – Say no to bullying

- Explore the definition of bullying.
- Explore different scenarios to decide whether bullying is taking place and discuss why/why not.
- Explore things to do if you think you are being bullied/witness bullying.
