

Year 1 Curriculum Information

Literacy

Our Books for this half term will be The Gruffalo and Sir Scallywag and the Golden Underpants

- Re-inforce and apply word level/sentence level skills through several styles of reading e.g. shared reading, guided reading and individual reading.
- Read, write and apply instructions, linking in with our topic and major celebrations where appropriate.
- Look at stories closely, looking at sequencing, drama, simple recounts, description writing and linking ideas from the text to other areas of the curriculum.
- Continue to develop Nelson handwriting.

Numeracy

- Recite numbers to 30 and beyond.
- Recall number bonds within 10/20.
- Sing x 2, X5 and X10 song and counting multiples.
- Recognise even and odd numbers.
- Use the word 'difference' as a subtracting word.
- Look at how heavy, or how much water an object holds practically and begin to record their findings.
- Use the language of position and discuss turning, using $\frac{1}{2}$ turns and $\frac{1}{4}$ turns.

Topic – Space

The children will be identifying and describing the moon and space, where it is and comparing the moon with earth.

They will be looking at other planets in the Solar System.

They will discover who the first people on the moon were and other visits that have been made.

We will be making a rocket and testing how far it flies!

Use keyboard to write captions/labels.

Use programmes on the computer, LOGO and Purple Mash, which involve moving the cursor in straight lines and corners, and develop this work by using i-pads and bebots.

Use simple programmes to help in phonics and Numeracy.
