

Year 1 Curriculum Information

Literacy

- Re-inforce and apply word level/sentence level skills through several styles of reading e.g. shared reading, guided reading and individual reading.
- Recognise repeating phrases within certain stories.
- Read, write and apply instructions, linking in with our topic where appropriate.
- Read and perform different poems, and begin to learn them by heart.
- Use story patterns as models for their own writing.
- Continue to develop Nelson handwriting.

Numeracy

- Recite numbers to 30 and beyond.
- Recall number bonds within 10/20.
- Sing x 2, X5 and X10 song and counting multiples.
- Recognise even and odd numbers.
- Use the word 'difference' as a subtracting word.
- Look at how heavy, or how much water an object holds practically and begin to record their findings.
- Use the language of position and discuss turning, using $\frac{1}{2}$ turns and $\frac{1}{4}$ turns.

Topic – Castles and Knights

History and Geography

The children will be looking at castles:

They will look at where castles were built in England and why they were built.

They will understand what a Norman Motte and Bailey castle is and know all of the key parts of the castle. The children will research a local castle.

Science – The children will be looking at different materials used to make castles and their properties, the children will also focus on grouping the materials depending on their properties.

They will also do some simple investigations which will involve simple measuring.
