- Focus upon use of capital letters and full stops.

- Learn days of the week and months of the year.

Art & DT



<u>MATHS</u> – Place Value, Addition and Subtraction

- Sort and count groups of objects.

- Count backwards to complete number sequences.
- Find one more and one less of numbers to 10.
- Match one object to the other one to one correspondence.
- Compare objects, using the language equal to, more, less, greater than, less than, fewer. Extend to using < and > .
- Order groups of objects.
- Record and complete number sentences involving addition and subtraction to 10.
- Learn addition facts to numbers to 10.
- Learn number bonds to 10.
- Solve missing number problems to 10.

- Identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Sort animals into different animal groups.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
