Year One - Curriculum Information

Literacy

Our texts for this ½ term will be The Smartest Giant in Town and The day the crayons quit.

Year 1 will -

- Complete work recounting text and topic work.
- They will also have a go at writing letters and diaries.
- Make use of a range of texts in shared, guided and individual reading e.g. stories, non-fiction and poetry.
- To be able to use simple dictionaries and understand alphabetical organisation.
- Continue to read their home reading book.

Numeracy

- Count in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's and put these numbers into equal groups.
- Recall all their doubles up to 10.
- To know ½'s and ¼'s.
- Understand work on direction by following simple instructions and using mathematical words to describe position
- Use number facts to add or subtract pairs of numbers up to 20.
- Solve simple procedures involving capacity.

I.C.T.

- Practical use of the interactive smart board in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Use of related Numeracy and Literacy programmes in the computer suite.
- Logging on to the computer and off the computer and logging on to Education City and Purple Mash.
- Simple coding programmes.

Topic -Weather

- Find out about the weather in different countries.
- Record weather chart for the week, recording weather each day.
- Children to watch and present a weather report to the class.
- Learn about different weather symbols.
- Explore different plants when outside for weather activities and learn different parts of a plant.
- Grow own plants in classroom.
- Collect rain using a rain gauge and measure this using scientific equipment and use this to discuss importance of water for plants.
- Discuss weather needed to grow plants rain and sun (water and light).
