ENGLISH

Writing


- Practice forming lower-case letters and capital letters correctly with attention to size to one another throughout a word.
- When writing segment spoken words into phonemes with increasing independence.
- Learn to spell non- negotiable words Y1/Y2
- Writing stories narrative and poems based on Traditional tales

Phonics/Spelling

- Begin Read Write inc phonics programme to increase reading fluency
- Revise and write phonic sounds from Year 1 to develop increased accuracy in spelling. The spelling lists for this half term will be posted on Seesaw in week 2.

Reading

- Read text daily in class, sounding out unfamiliar words more accurately with Rwinc
- Retell traditional tales read in class. Learn poems by heart read in class.



Topic - Castles

- In Design Technology and History explore castles as a theme and also our school and life memories of a timeline.
- Add memories of our life and at school on a timeline.
- Local castles Locate medieval castles near to us and discuss their features. .
- Sing songs about marching; add music to poems about castles.
- Construct parts of a castle using different materials and methods, working as a team.
- Design a coat of arms.
- Read stories with a castle theme.


MATHS

Place Value, Addition and Subtraction

- Read numerals to 100 in numerals and words
- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in 10s from any number, forward and backward
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (10s, ones)
- Learn fact families and number bonds of 10 and 20
- Find 10 more and 10 less of a 2-digit number
- Add and Subtract 2-digit and 1-digit numbers
