Home Learning

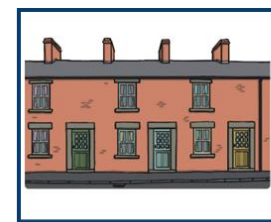
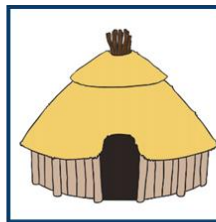
- Ask your grown ups if they can remember what their house was like when they were little. What has changed and what has stayed the same?
